Paul's conversion. The Bible mentioned Paul in *Acts 7:58* at the stoning of Stephen, the first Christian **martyr**. It says that when Stephen was put to death, the men who stoned him laid their coats at the feet of a young man whose

name was Saul (Paul). Saul may have been a rabbi in the synagogue when Stephen was brought to trial (*Acts 6:9*). The Bible says in *Acts 8:1* that Saul **consented** to Stephen's death.
