Mark held up his finger and named the states.

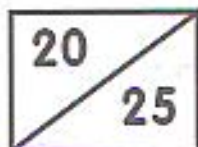

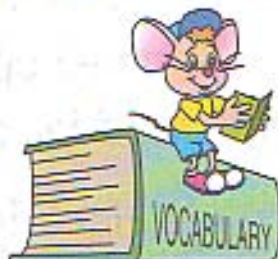
